



SCHOLARSHIP

The Smoky Mountain Paralegal Association is pleased to award a scholarship in the amount of at least \$500.00.

Funds are to be used to pursue a paralegal education. Checks will be made payable to the scholarship recipient and recipient's paralegal educational institution.

REQUIREMENTS

The successful candidate must be enrolled as full-time student in a paralegal program at a SMPA Sustaining Member educational institute or be a SMPA student member. A candidate should also have completed 6 hours of study in his or her major and be in good academic standing.

An application must be complete and have the following supporting documentation attached:

1. College Transcript
2. Academic Recommendation Letter
3. Personal Recommendation Letter
4. One page, double-spaced, essay explaining why you have chosen the paralegal profession and why you should be awarded the SMPA scholarship.

Applications complete with all supporting documentation must be postmarked on or before November 15 and mailed to:

Incomplete applications will not be eligible for consideration.

SELECTION PROCESS

SMPA scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, color, creed, sex or age.

Selection will be based on evaluation of essay response, financial need, scholastic achievements, participation in campus and paralegal program activities, and community service.
